**AN ORDINANCE OF FORWARD TOWNSHIP AMENDING ORDINANCE 74-1
TO CHANGE THE STREET OPENING FEE**

WHEREAS, Forward Township has adopted an Ordinance regulating the opening of streets within the municipal boundaries of Forward Township.

WHEREAS, The Ordinance has established a permit fee in the amount of sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) for each street opening.

WHEREAS, Forward Township has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the Township to raise the permit fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township of Forward and it is hereby enacted and ordained by virtue of the authority vested in the same as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 5 of Ordinance 74-1 shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

“SECTION FIVE. Before any permit shall be issued, the applicant shall pay to Forward Township, a permit fee in an amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

Before any permit shall be issued, the applicant shall, in addition to the permit fee, pay to Forward Township, the approximate reasonable cost of making the first inspection as determined by the Township Supervisors.

The application must be accompanied by both fees as prescribed above.”


SECTION 2. All parts, clauses, sections or provisions of Ordinance No. 74-1, that conflict with the above referenced amendment set forth in Section 4 hereof are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to remedy the conflict.

SECTION 3. All other Ordinances or parts of other Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to remedy the conflict.

Notice is hereby given that the following Ordinance shall be presented to the Board of Supervisors, Township of Forward, to be considered for adoption at the regular meeting to be held on Monday, June 10, 1974, 7:30 P.M., Municipal Building, Route 136, Forward Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania.

ORDINANCE NO. 74-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FORWARD, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, UNDER AUTHORITY OF ACT NO. 23 OF 1974, AMENDING SECTION 1156, ARTICLE XI, SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE, REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION UPON TOWNSHIP STREETS OF ANY TYPE OF OBSTRUCTION AND THE MAKING OF OPENINGS AND EXCAVATIONS IN THE STREETS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF FORWARD AND THE PROTECTION, REFILLING, RESURFACING AND REPAVING OF THE SAME AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

UNDER authority of Act No. 23 of 1974, amending Section 1156, Article XI, Second Class Township Code, the Township of Forward hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION ONE. The following words when used in this ordinance shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except in those instances where the context clearly indicates otherwise:

(a) The word "street" shall mean any public street, avenue, road, square, alley, highway or other public place located in the Township of Forward and established for the use of vehicles.

(b) The word "person" shall mean and include any natural person, partnership, firm, association or corporation.

In this ordinance the singular shall include the plural and the masculine the feminine and the neuter.

SECTION TWO. It shall be unlawful for any person to undertake any of the activities or do any of the things listed in Section Three below in any street in the Township of Forward without first securing a permit as hereinafter described and paying the first inspection fee as hereinafter provided.

SECTION THREE. It shall be unlawful for any person to construct railroads or street railways or railroad or street railway crossings upon any Township street, nor may any gas pipe, water pipe, electric conduits, or other piping, be laid upon or in nor shall any cuts, openings or excavations for any purpose be made in any Township street, nor shall any telephone, telegraph or electric light or power poles, or any coal pipes or any other obstructions be erected upon or in, any portion of a Township street, except under such conditions, restrictions and regulations relating to the installation and maintenance thereof, as may be prescribed in permits granted by the Township for such purposes.

SECTION FOUR. Any person who shall desire to make any opening, cut or excavation or construct any obstruction in any of the streets in the Township of Forward shall make application to the Township Secretary or Permit Officer, if any, for the purpose. Such application shall be made in triplicate upon forms to be furnished by the Township. In addition to furnishing all information prescribed on such form, the application will contain an agreement on the part of the applicant that the work will be done in full compliance with the ordinance of the Township and the laws of the Commonwealth in relation thereto, and that the applicant shall well and truly same, defend and keep harmless the Township and indemnify it against any and all actions, suits, demands, payments, costs and charges for or by reason of the proposed opening, cut, or excavation or construction of such obstruction, and all damages to persons or property resulting in any manner therefrom, or occurring in the prosecution of

the work, connected therewith, or from any other matter, cause or thing related thereto.

Such application shall be accompanied by three (3) copies of an accurate sketch or drawing identifying the street to be affected, location of the intended facility, width of the street right of way, width of the traveler's portion thereof and a dimension to the nearest intersecting street.

SECTION FIVE. Before any permit shall be issued, the applicant shall pay to the Borough Secretary or Permit Officer, if any, a permit fee in an amount which will be determined from time to time by the Department of Transportation, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and published as its Schedule of Fees for Highway Occupancy Permits and Restoration Charges.

Before any permit shall be issued the applicant shall, in addition to the permit fee, pay to the same officer, the approximate reasonable cost of making the first inspection hereafter described, to-wit, \$15.00.

The application must be accompanied by both fees prescribed above.

SECTION SIX. Any person who shall cut, open or excavate any street in the Township shall, at his expense, thoroughly and completely refill the opening or excavation, puddling, compacting and ramming, so as to prevent any settling thereafter, and shall restore the surface to the same condition as it was before the cutting, opening or excavation, and such restoration shall be in accordance with the specifications of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania which are hereby adopted as the specifications of the Township for restoration of surfaces of streets in the Township; as restored the surface shall conform to the proper grade and be of the same surface covering as the part of the thoroughfare immediately adjoining the opening.

SECTION SEVEN. Upon completion of the work for which a permit shall have been granted, same shall be inspected by the Township Supervisors. When necessary, they will enforce compliance with this ordinance and the conditions, restrictions and regulations prescribed by the Township.

SECTION EIGHT. If any settlement of the road surface or other defect shall appear in the work contrary to this ordinance or to the conditions, restrictions and regulations of the Township, compliance therewith will be enforced.

If the applicant shall fail to rectify any such settlement or other defect within sixty (60) days after written notice from the Township Supervisors to do so, the Township Supervisors may do the work and impose upon the applicant the cost thereof, together with an additional twenty per centum (20%) of such cost.

SECTION NINE. Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to require a permit in advance for emergency repairs necessary for the safety of the public or restoration or continuance of public utility or other public service, but application for such permit and fees shall be submitted as herein prescribed within five days after completion of the work and thereafter, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall apply.

SECTION TEN. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject, upon Summary Conviction before a District Justice of the Peace, to pay a fine of not more than \$100.00, plus costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs of prosecution, shall be imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days. Nothing in this section shall bar an indictment at common law for commission of a nuisance and obstruction of public streets.

SECTION ELEVEN. Any ordinance or part of ordinance inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed insofar as it is inconsistent herewith.
